Biography

Phyllis Trible (b.1932) is an internationally known lecturer and biblical scholar. She is a leading authority on what is now known as feminist hermeneutics, as well as literary and rhetorical modes of biblical criticism. Trible's first two books, *God and the Rhetoric of Sexuality* (1978) and *Texts of Terror: Literary-Feminist Readings of Biblical Narratives* (1984) are considered groundbreaking works in feminist biblical scholarship.

Trible was born in Richmond, Virginia on October 25, 1932. In 1950, she graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School and went on to earn her Bachelor of Arts degree from Meredith College in Raleigh, North Carolina in 1954, graduating *magna cum laude*. Following the advice of Ralph MacLain – a professor at Meredith College - Trible pursued graduate theological studies at the Union Theological Seminary in New York City. After two years in the B.D. (Bachelor of Divinity) program, she transferred to the Ph.D. program offered jointly by UTS and Columbia University. With her major in Old Testament, Trible completed the Ph.D. program in 1963, under the direction of James Muilenburg, Davenport Professor of Hebrew Literature and Languages at Union (1945-

1963). She also studied with Professors Samuel Terrien and George Landes of Union Seminary. Trible's relationship with Muilenburg in particular would have a salient effect on Trible's career through lifelong mentorship and friendship.

Trible's teaching career began with a three-year tenure at The Masters School in Dobbs Ferry, New York, from 1960 to 1963, undertaken during the same years she was completing her dissertation at Union on the Book of Jonah. In 1963, Trible began her formal teaching career at Wake Forest University (1963-1971) in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, first as Assistant then as Associate Professor of Religion. In 1971, she moved to Newton-Centre, Massachusetts to teach at Andover Newton Theological School (1971-1979). There, she held the posts of Associate Professor and Professor of Old Testament. In 1975, she was appointed Hitchcock Professor of Hebrew Language and Literature (1975-1979). In 1979, she was appointed Professor of Old Testament at Union Theological Seminary in New York City, the fourth woman to hold a full professorship at that seminary.

In 1981, Trible became the first woman to be named Baldwin Professor of Sacred Literature. She retired from Union in 1998, and was thereafter Baldwin Professor Emerita of Sacred Literature. In 1994, she would also serve as President of the Society of Biblical Literature. During this period of her career, Trible gave numerous lectures, speeches, and sermons as close by as Riverside Church and far afield as New Zealand and Japan. Throughout her academic and recreational travels, Trible came into contact with academic work, religious communities and cultural contexts that were critical in sculpting her scholarly sensibilities as well as her personal relationship to spirituality, gender identity, and academia.

Upon retiring from Union Seminary in 1998, Trible helped to found Wake Forest University Divinity School, where she served as Associate Dean and Professor of Biblical Studies from 1998 to 2001, and was University Professor from 2002 to 2012. She was instrumental in designing the school's curriculum, and remarkably was still living in New York City at the time that she helped found the school in North Carolina.

Trible has held temporary or summer-term roles in several theological and academic contexts, including Vancouver School of Theology in British Columbia, the Iliff School of Theology in Denver, the Pacific School of Religion, and Claremont Graduate School. In addition to teaching at many institutions, she was awarded a number of honorary degrees, including a Doctor of Divinity from Franklin College (1985), Doctor of Divinity from Lehigh University (1994), Doctor of Divinity from Wake Forest University (1997), and Doctor of Humane Letters from Meredith College (2001).

In the forward to her first book, *God and the Rhetoric of Sexuality* (1978), Trible writes the following:

Using feminist hermeneutics, I have tried to recover old treasures and discover new ones in the household of faith. Though some of these treasures are small, they are nonetheless valuable in a tradition that is often compelled to live by the remnant. This understanding has guided my vision since events symbolized by 1963 muted the proclamation of the mighty acts of God in history. Thus I dare not despise the day of little things (see Zech. 4:10).

Trible's early use of feminist hermeneutics to frame her engagement in biblical scholarship is evidenced through her extensive academic, professional and personal activities. She went on to publish further fundamental works in her field, including *Texts of Terror* (1984), and *Rhetorical Criticism: Context, Method, and the Book of Jonah* (1994). With Professor Letty Russell, she co-edited *Hagar, Sarah, and Their Children* (2006). With Professor B. Diane Lipsett, she co-edited *Faith and Feminism: Ecumenical Essays* (2014). She made further contributions through encyclopedic publications and mainstream discussions on religious studies, including contributing the entry on "Jonah" to *The New Interpreters' Bible* commentary series and appearing on Bill Moyers' 1995 PBS special *Genesis – A Living Conversation*. She provided an academic autobiographical sketch for the publication *I* (*Still*) *Believe: Essays on Ecumenical Scholarship* (2015). Trible's concomitant investments in literary criticism of the Bible, feminist theology, and books of the Old Testament (notably the Book of Jonah and narratives of violence against women) undergird these aspects of religious discourse today, and have been steadily elucidated over the course of her distinguished career.

In addition to her scholarly output, Trible's papers include valuable transcripts, research, and drafts of sermons, speeches, and memorial pieces written in honor of beloved colleagues, mentors, and peers. The materials arranged in this collection provide evidence of Trible's work as a mentor, guide and supportive individual in the lives of her students, colleagues and friends.

Today, Trible continues to pose questions to the academic and ecumenical community, both in terms of feminism and literary criticism's role in ecumenical scholarship. Her archive continues to grow, but in their current form the Trible Papers provide a sound introduction to Trible's formative position in the field of literary criticism of the Old Testament and women in the Bible, as well as her affiliations to significant figures in the theological community such as James Muilenburg and Samuel Terrien, her colleagueship with feminists such as Letty Russell. Finally, these papers reflect her research and planning process when teaching and writing, as well as her activities

responding to, critiquing, and engaging in both classical and innovative modes of biblical discourse.

Collection Scope and Content Note

The Trible Papers span 61 boxes and consist of textual materials, photographs, graphic materials, bound materials, audiovisual matter, and realia providing historical and intellectual evidence of Trible's numerous activities within and beyond her career at Union. This collection forms the foundation of the Archives of Women in Theological Scholarship at Union Theological Seminary, and is divided into five series: Correspondence, Education, Teaching and Professional Activities, Writings and Public Engagement, and General.

- Series 1: Correspondence, 1955-2013 (4 boxes, 1.75 lin. ft.)
 - This series consists of Trible's correspondence primarily with other scholars and colleagues, often including enclosures of manuscripts, working papers, and materials relating to publications. Materials are divided into three subseries and consist primarily of letters, pamphlets and working papers, photographs, postcards and paper-based artifacts given to Trible by her students and colleagues throughout her career. These materials were arranged in loose chronological order, an order which has been maintained and divided into the following series to reflect the arrangement and nature of Trible's correspondence:
 - <u>Subseries 1A: Professional, 1972-2005 (1 box, 0.5 lin. ft.)</u>
 Materials consist primarily of letters regarding tenure referees, interviews, and exchanges relating to speaking engagements.
 - Subseries 1B: Academic and Personal, 1955-2013 (2 boxes, 0.75 lin. ft.)

Materials consist primarily of correspondence arranged chronologically and include personal correspondence as well as postcards, photographs, working papers annotated by friends and colleagues, and paper-based artworks given to Trible by colleagues.

Subseries 1C: By Name, 1981-2006 (1 box, 0.5 lin. ft.)
 Correspondence with Trible's colleagues organized by name. Files consist of some correspondence but largely of annotated articles, drafts of papers, memorial materials, and slides relating to Trible's relationships to her colleagues. Notable among these materials are photographs, slides, and a speech entitled "The Legacy of James Muilenburg" relating to Trible's dear

mentor and friend. Further materials relating to Trible's relationship with Muilenburg can be found throughout the collection, in Series 2: Education as course notes and exams written in Muilenburg's classes, in Series 4B: Articles and Commentary, showing Trible's biographical writing on Muilenburg for *The New Interpreters Bible* commentary series, and Series 5: General in the form of earthenware artifacts collected during an archaeological dig In Jerusalem with the Albright School, later given to Trible as gifts.

• Series 2: Education, 1950-2004 (8 boxes, 3.75 lin. ft.)

This series spans 8 boxes and consists of course notes and study cards, course syllabi, final examinations and liturgical notebooks chiefly arranged by course code or instructor. There are also clippings, pamphlets, unpublished works, alumni publications and yearbooks from Trible's time at Meredith College (1954), Union Theological Seminary, and Columbia University (1956-1960). The series is thus subdivided:

- Subseries 2A: Meredith College, 1950-2004 (3 boxes, 1.5 lin. ft.)
 3 boxes consistently primarily of course notes arranged chronologically as well as alumni materials including Trible's College yearbooks from 1951-1953.
- Subseries 2B: Union Theological Seminary/Columbia, 1954-1963 (5 boxes, 2.25 lin. ft.)

Subject files and course notebooks arranged chronologically, with course codes and instructors' names sometimes provided by Trible as marginalia. Boxes 4 and 5 include handwritten and typescript drafts toward Trible's Jonah dissertation.

- <u>Series 3: Teaching & Professional Affiliations, 1960-2012 (7 boxes, 4 lin. ft.)</u>
 This series comprises 4 subseries and includes materials spanning the majority of Trible's extensive teaching career.
 - Subseries 3A: Early Teaching: Wake Forest University, Andover
 Newton Theological School and Other, 1960-1998 (1 box, 0.5 lin. ft.)

 This subseries consists of notes toward course syllabi, articles and clippings during her teaching tenure at The Masters School in the final years of her dissertation at Union/Columbia (1960-1963), as Assistant and

Associate Professor of Religion at Wake Forest University (1963-1971), Associate Professor and Professor of Old Testament and Hebrew Language and Literature at Andover Newton Theological School (1971-1979).

• Subseries 3B: Union Theological Seminary, 1965-[2012] with gaps (4 boxes, 2 lin. ft.)

Subseries 3B consists of correspondence, photographs, pamphlets, clippings, course syllabi, notes and research files relating to Trible's appointment to Union, her administrative and teaching activities at UTS from 1965-2012. Note that some syllabi, teaching and administrative materials here relate to Trible's formal career at Union but pre- or post-date her formal employment with the Seminary.

• Subseries 3C: Wake Forest University and WF Divinity School, 1983-2011 (1 box, 0.5 lin. ft.)

Subseries 3C consists similarly of correspondence, publicity, teaching notes, administrative correspondence, bulletins and convocation programs relating to Trible's ongoing work with Wake Forest as Professor of Biblical Studies, and later as Dean upon Wake Forest Divinity School's founding in 1998.

Subseries 3D: Presidency, Society of Biblical Literature, 1992-1994 (1 box, 0.25 lin. ft.)

Subseries 3D consists of conference materials, transcripts of speeches and administrative records pertaining to Trible's term as president of the Society of Biblical Literature in 1994.

• Series 4: Writings and Public Engagement, 1954-2015 (11 boxes, 13.5 lin. ft.)

This series encompasses Trible's extensive handwritten and typescript drafts, annotations, and final manuscripts of her formative publications. Arranged as distinct subseries are Trible's articles, essays and social commentary, and materials covering her extensive lecture and sermon-giving activities. The series concludes with Trible's research files arranged alphabetically by subject.

Subseries 4A: Books, 1974-2008 (9 boxes, 4.5 lin. ft.)
 Handwritten and typescript drafts and manuscripts arranged chronologically by publication date: God and the Rhetoric of Sexuality

(1978), Texts of Terror (1984), Rhetorical Criticism (1994), Hagar, Sarah and Their Children (co-edited with Letty Russell, 2006), and General, which consists of early 2000s documentation regarding royalties from Trible's books.

• Subseries 4B: Articles and Commentary, 1968-2014 (10 boxes, 5 lin. ft.)

Subseries 4B consists of articles, essays, encyclopedia entries and reviews written by Trible for magazines, scholarly journals, periodicals, newspapers, and serial publications. These are arranged in chronological order.

• Subseries 4C: Lectures and Sermons, 1960-2015 (8 boxes, 4 lin. ft.)

This subseries consists of transcripts, working documents, and final drafts of lectures, sermons, and speeches given by Trible in a number of contexts, including international lecture series, academic conferences and ecumenical settings. Distinctive lecturing events include the Beecher Lecture, Trible's lecture tours abroad in Australia, New Zealand, and Japan, and the Trible Lecture Series at Wake Forest. Interfiled among these materials are mixed lecture and correspondence files that were accumulated together and maintained in their original order.

Subseries 4D: Research - by Subject, 196?-[2008] (5 boxes, 2.5 lin. ft.)

Subseries 4D consists of Trible's research files arranged by subject. Topics covered here are diverse and reflective of Trible's intersectional academic and personal interests, notably including files on feminism and sexuality in the Old Testament, literary criticism of the Bible, files on specific female figures in the Bible. Research files relating to the Book of Jonah would be of interest to researchers curious about Trible's career-spanning work on Jonah from her Union/Columbia dissertation through her academic career.

Series 5: General, 1965-2009 (9 boxes, 6.25 lin. ft.)

Series 5 consists of Trible's honorary degrees and awards, various translations of her books as well as annotated selections from her personal library, 5 inches of photographs and clippings relating to Biblical iconography and the Book of Jonah.

Subseries 5A: Degrees and Awards, 1985-2009 (1 box, 0.5 lin. ft.)
 Honorary doctorates from Franklin College, Lehigh University, Meredith College, as well as photographs from Wake Forest's 1997
 Commencement, a Trible Scholars Certificate from Swarthmore
 Presbyterian Church. N.B.: Honorary doctorate from Wake Forest not included.

Subseries 5B: Books and Memorabilia, 197?-2008 (3 boxes and 1 OS, 2.75 lin. ft.)

Includes translations of Trible's works in Dutch, German and Korean, as well as clippings relating to Biblical iconography and Jonah. One oversize box containing a Meredith College alumni publication featuring a biographical sketch on Trible, a photocopy of the musical score *Jonas* by Giacomo Carissimi, and Trible's oversize honorary doctorate from Lehigh University.

Subseries 5C: Audiovisual and Realia, [19??]-2000 (5 boxes, 2.75 lin. ft.)

Materials consist of 5 VHS tapes, 51 slides, 3 reel-to-reel cassettes (one fragile), 36 audio cassette tapes, and one custom box containing 2 earthenware Palestinian artifacts procured by Muilenburg during an archaeological visit to Jerusalem with the Albright Institution of Archaeological Research [1953-1954]. Service copies of audiovisual materials may be furnished on a case-by-case basis. Fees or access restrictions may apply.

Highlights from these materials include a videorecording of a dance performance inspired by the Old Testament story of Sarah and Hagar, a recording of one of Trible's introductory Old Testament 106 Lectures, 7" reel cassettes of James Muilenburg speaking at Wake Forest in 1965, and approximately 30 assorted audiocassette recordings of Trible's lectures including the Beecher Lectures, speeches at 1982's Shalom Hall Theological Conference, a sermon at the Reformed Church in Bronxville in 1999, and an interview in 2000.

Processing

As the Burke Library acquires Trible's papers, attempts are made to maintain the original order she imposed throughout the course of her career. Folded materials were

flattened. Newspaper clippings were photocopied on acid free paper. Staples, rubber bands, and metal clips were removed. All materials were placed in acid-free folders and boxes.
